- Arrive ½ hour before service begins.
- Smile and greet people as they enter the church.
- Goal: one person by the front the door (opening the door), someone handing out bulletins, if possible, someone outside greeting and helping people outside.
- Stay in fellowship hall till after worship starts to greet late arrivals.
- After worship handout a popcorn to guests and thank people or say "have a great week"
- Watch for anyone sitting alone during coffee and donuts and have someone sit with them.
- Have 3 children ready to carry the cross and light the candles right before worship and send the candle lighters to extinguish candles at the end of the service.
- Take up the offering. The pastor will invite you to come forward to receive the offering.
- On Communion Sunday make pastor aware of individuals who need communion brought to them in the pews.
- Most of all smile and have fun!!! We are welcoming people to experience the love of Jesus.
